

Courses Update 22nd May 2020

Working within the BIGGA guidelines, works carried out include the following:

Killermont

Greens and surrounds top dressed in anticipation of rain (...which came!).

Greens and tees cut once.

Fairways cut twice.

General maintenance....as permitted.

Gailes

Greens and surrounds top dressed.

Tees, apron, approaches and greens cut three times.

Fairways cut three times due to growth levels caused by the rainfall.

General maintenance....as permitted.

The latest guidance from Scottish Golf states "As Golf Clubs prepare to open, routine maintenance practices can be restored, with the primary consideration being to ensure staff safety". We will seek clarification on what works can be carried out in the lead up to play, with our staff welfare at the forefront of our plans.
